Braunton Parish Council have submitted their neighbourhood plan proposal to North Devon Council in accordance with the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended).

North Devon Council is now inviting representations on the neighbourhood plan in accordance with Regulation 16 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended). **Representations need to be received by 5pm on 30th January 2023.** Late representations will not be accepted.

You can use the form in the link to submit your representations about the neighbourhood plan. Forms are also available from the Parish Council office.
