Have you heard the BUZZ?

The Saunton Park residents have planted a fantastic garden along the wide verge on Saunton Road. The aim of the verge is not only to look aesthetically pleasing to the eye but the wide variety of plants also provide a nectar rich stop off for pollinating insects and a habitat and refuge for many beneficial insects. These insects in turn provide birds, bats and small mammals with a much needed food source.

All plants on this verge have been donated by local residents and we would like to thank them and the volunteers who have given their time to plant and maintain the verge for the enjoyment of the wider community.

Braunton Parish Council are encouraging more wildflowers and insects by leaving some verges to grow naturally. This is a pilot scheme being trialled in areas of Braunton with advice from the Bumblebee

Conservation Trust They particularly want to encourage the now rare Brown Banded Carder Bee and Moss Carder Bee, both once common throughout Devon but whose one remaining strong hold is our North Devon Coast area. These verges can provide a valuable habitat for the growth of wildflowers again, a much needed refuelling stop for our insects. We would also like to thank Knowle Community Group and Love Braunton for their help in planting up other areas in Braunton.
