181/2018/19	<b>Age Concern</b>	The Chair welcomed Andrea Scott and Keith Lockhurst the Director and Treasurer of Age Concern Barnstaple.  Andrea Scott explained that Age Concern Barnstaple were an independent charity which has been operating for the past 25 years. The charity has in the past been sustainable but relies on donations and legacies. In recent years it has experienced financial difficulties with funding cuts

and it has not been left a legacy for 11 years.

Andrea further explained the services that the Charity provide, a summary is attached as Appendix A. They cover a 5 mile radius which includes Braunton and out their 220 clients 14 live in Braunton. In order to continue they need to raise £25k which has been cut from their County funding
