Fun New Play Tower for Kids in Knowle

The play park in Knowle will soon be getting an overhaul with some of the old equipment making way for a fantastic new castle themed wooden play tower. 'Knowle Castle' will have a 1.2 metre high platform, fireman's pole, ramp with ropes and grips and a scramble net all set onto a rubber mulch base. Braunton Parish Council has worked closely with Knowle Community Group to develop the plans which will take place in two phases as funding becomes available. The second phase will include a new swing set with a birds nest swing and a communal area.

Braunton Parish Council has allocated £3500 from the car park income and has secured additional funding from Braunton Rotary Club (£500), The Vivian Moon Braunton Community Trust Fund (£500), North Devon Community Councillor Grant (£350) and North Devon Council Communities Together Fund (£4000). Section 106 funding has also been allocated towards phase two. Members of Knowle Community Group have kindly offered to carry out the ground works and removal of the old pieces of equipment.



Parish Elections
