Plastic Free Coastlines

Braunton Parish Council is pleased support the Plastic to Free Coastlines Initiative, a campaign set up by Surfers against Sewage (SAS) to fight the plastic pollution that blights our beaches and strangles our seashores. As well as cleaning up our beaches it particularly focuses on stopping the problem at source, starting with refusing single-use plastics.

80% of marine litter comes from the land....13 million tonnes of plastics leaks into the marine environment. A bottle will last for more than 400 years and once broken down into micro-plastic pieces, can enter the food chain. Every piece of plastic ever made is still out there in the environment...which ends up having an adverse implication on wildlife, the economy and human health.
