



## Hedgehog Highway Project

Can you help us to make Braunton a more hedgehog friendly parish? Did you know that hedgehogs can travel up to 2 miles a night! If you have a wall or fencing around your property this could be inhibiting access to



allow them to forage for food and meet mates. A Hedgehog Highway is a 5 inch gap in a fence or wall allowing access for Hedgehogs.

Braunton Parish Council have signed up for the Hedgehogs R Us Highway Project and are offering free hedgehog shaped fence surrounds to raise awareness to the plight of Hedgehogs. The fence surrounds are made of recycled plastic and can be easily fitted to allow hedgehogs to travel through your neighbourhood. The surrounds are free and available from the Parish Council office next to the library. Get the whole family involved to help make your garden more hedgehog friendly.
