We will soon be going live with the newly refurbished Braunton Community Work Hub, an affordable flexible work space opening in the old police station\* building in the centre of Braunton.

Hot Desks

£5/ half day £10/ day Work hubs offer environments of collaboration and innovation, spaces of vibrant communities and shared aspirations. A place for home-workers, lone-workers and entrepreneurs to share a work space, exchange ideas and expertise, interactions unavailable to those working alone at home or at café tables.

Who knows, those ideas discussed over the coffee machine or mulled over with fellow co-workers may actually be the start of something very exciting.

Work hubs attract innovative thinkers, and by creating a nurturing environment and running business support and social events, peer to peer support is one of the biggest bonuses of the hub. Why not be part of this growing network of users?

So if you work out and about or are a tradesperson and need to catch up on administration away from the usual distractions at home, you can grab a



free coffee with access to fast broadband from just £5 for half a day!

Or maybe you need short or long-term office space or a room to carry out interviews with great facilities including:

- Secure bike parking



The newly refurbished modern offices, Tarka, Linhay and Signal, can be rented individually without long-term binding contracts. These offices can accommodate 1 or 2 people. The Interview Room has 1 desk and can be rented from as little as half a day for £5.
