Cashless Payment Options Coming Soon

Easier * Safer * Faster

Braunton Parish Council have been researching ways to improve payments for its car parks and will soon be introducing a cashless payment option allowing you to avoid touching the car park ticket machine completely. (The cash payments will still be available.) Other advantages are:

- once you have set it up you'll never need to worry about having the right change for parking again
- you don't have to rush back to your car – you can extend your parking on the go
- why stand in a queue in the rain when you can pay for your parking quickly and securely with the app?



Parking Permits

If you park regularly in Braunton you can significantly reduce the cost and take out the stress by purchasing a permit for the Caen Street overflow carpark. The cost is £157.50 for the remainder of the year to end March 2022. (The annual permit is £210.) This works out at a cost of just over £4 per week which is less than a full day.
