# Parish Council takes on County's grass verges

Braunton Parish Council have for the second year running Devon taken on County Council's urban highway grass cutting service.

In April 2015, due to financial Devon County Council drastically reduced its grass cutting service changing policy to only control growth on the highway for the following safety reasons:

- To maintain visibility highway areas/splays for users:
- To provide forward visibility to sians.

The grassed areas to be cut comprise of approximately 32,136 square metres and are situated throughout Braunton. Knowle and Wrafton.

The Parish Council have secured funding towards maintaining the County's grass for verges 2017/18.



The visual appearance of our important village is to local residents and businesses and that our tourism ensures continues to flourish during the peak season. The Parish Council will continue to maintain the County's grass verges to a good standard and consider ways that it make the service can more sustainable in the future.

The price remains the same at £175 for the year. This effectively gives you 313 days parking for less than the cost of 48 days (based on the daily rate of £3.70).

Parking is free on Sundays.


## Snow Warden Scheme

The Parish Council has signed up for the Devon County Council Snow Warden Scheme. Under this scheme we are supplied with 5 tons of salt which is stored in a secure location and its distribution is strictly controlled by the Snow Warden and his team of volunteers from Braunton Caen Rotary Club.

This will not have any effect on the existing salt bins which will still be serviced by the county council.

The scheme complements the existing Highway Services and increases the safety of pedestrian movement during periods of extreme winter Weather.
