Following the closure of the last remaining bank in the village, the Parish Council are keen to keep banking services available in Braunton and have agreed to allow a mobile banking service to be based in Caen Street Overflow Car Park on Wednesday mornings and Fridays.

The opening times are as follows:

Wednesday	09:30 - 11:30
Friday	09:30 - 12:15 13:00 - 15:15

The new service will be available from Wednesday 14th June 2017 and Friday 16th June 2017 onwards.

There will also be additional cash withdrawal machines installed by local businesses in the village.

Maple Tree

Sadly the Norway Maple on the village green has suffered from a number of stresses over recent years.

A report from the North Devon Council's Landscape and Countryside Officer, stated that he suspects that the Norway Maple tree's decline is as a result of soil compaction, resulting in the root death as a consequence of not being able to access adequate water and nutrients and then subsequent infection with Honey Fungus.

The tree will be removed and a proposal for replanting the area will be considered by the Council.
