Braunton Countryside Centre Improvements

The redevelopment of the Braunton Countryside Centre is now completed and was opened in time for the Easter weekend.



The Countryside Centre Chairman, Ken Rutherford, accepted handover of the keys from the building contractors, CDL Southwest Limited on 31st March. Ken said, “we are immensely proud of this achievement following several years of trying. Nearly all the funding was from local sources including the Parish Council, Fullbrook CIC and Vivian Moon. Several new exhibitions and projects are planned for this year and there will be a grand opening later in the summer.”



The Parish Council, who own the building, have turned the frontage into a community shared space. The Chairman of the Parish Council, Cllr Derrick Spear says, “This area, located in the heart of the village, can now be used by local schools, clubs, not-for-profit organisations and charities for educational purposes, raising awareness of local issues, meetings, fund raising and other community-led events providing an all year round area that can be utilised by the local community.” Cllr Spear went on to say that, “the Parish Council are delighted that the works have been successfully completed and the building and new exhibitions are now open for the enjoyment of locals and visitors alike.” The project was supported by DCC and NDC through the Town and Parish fund.

For flooding or blocked drains click on this section and you will be able to pinpoint on a map the location of the drain and enter details about the problem. It is also possible to upload a photo to the site.

You can report various issues including potholes, fallen trees, obstructions and streetlights or traffic lights which are out.
