		Members were concerned regarding restricting visibility of oncoming traffic on the A361 when exiting the Chaloners Road Car Park. Devon County Council have already installed a signal box for the Pelican Crossing which has partially restricted visibility. Erecting panelling would further obscure visibility not only to oncoming traffic but also pedestrians using the pavement.
		RESOLVED: To recommend to full Council that due to health and safety and the Parish Council's responsibility to

motorists exiting its car park in Chaloners road to decline the request for panelling to be installed on the boundary fence.
