



Braunton Programme of Remembrance 2024

Remembrance Sunday Sunday 10th November 2024

Come along to our Annual Remembrance Sunday Service and Parade on Sunday 10th November 2024, where we gather as a community to show our collective respect to all of those who gave their tomorrow for our today.

Time: Arrive at 9.30am. Parade to proceed at 10.00am.

Meeting Point: Parade participants will meet in Caen Street Car Park, Caen Street, EX33 1AA

Parade Route: The Parade will exit Caen Street Car Park onto Caen Street, turn left along Chaloners Road, turn right into Church Street and stop at St. Brannock's Church.

Church Service: Starts at 10.50am at St. Brannock's Church, people attending to be inside the Church no later than 10.45am. All are very welcome to attend but places are limited and will be given on a first come first served basis - there will be a PA system outside the Church so people can listen to the Service.

At 11am a two-minute silence will be observed giving guests, residents and visitors the opportunity to make their own personal silent tribute to all those who have died in service of their Country.

Parade Return: Following the Service the Parade will leave St. Brannock's Church and proceed at 12pm then turn left along Chaloners Road. At the Memorial Gardens the Commanding Officer 24 Commando Royal Engineers

will take the march past salute. The Parade will continue right into Caen Street and return to Caen Street Car Park, where the Parade will halt and dismiss.



Additional information:

Road closures will be in place on Caen Street, Chaloners Road and Church Street during the Parade.

All ex-service men and women and serving members of HM Forces are welcome to take part in the Parade. Please report to the Regimental Sergeant Major at 9.30am, in Caen Street Car Park. The Parade of Service Men and Women will leave Caen Street Car Park at 10.00am.

An area of the Caen Street Car Park will be cordoned off for Parade participants to wait and line up.

Thank you to Milestone Infrastructure Ltd for agreeing to oversee the traffic management during the Parade.

An Act of Remembrance with a two-minute silence will take place on the Village Green, Caen Street, Braunton on Monday the 11th November to mark Armistice Day. Please gather on the Village Green no later than 10.50am.

Time: Arrive 10.50am. A two-minute silence at 11am.
