THE KING'S PROCLAMATION

The National Proclamation of the new Monarch took place on Saturday 10th September at 1100hrs at St. James' Palace, London. The following day, Sunday 11th September, the Proclamation was read out at 1200hrs in Edinburgh, Cardiff and Belfast. It was then read again at 1305hrs at County Hall in Exeter by the High Sheriff of Devon and finally followed by the Lord Mayor of Exeter reading the Proclamation at 1500hrs on the

same day at the Exeter Cathedral accompanied by the Dean from Exeter Cathedral.



As per the protocol the Chair of Braunton Parish Council, Councillor Liz Spear read the Proclamation at 1600hrs at the Memorial Shelter.
